

Marriage Vision Casting Worksheet

To get you started, we want you to focus on casting your marriage vision for the next month. This will give you a great idea of how you can use vision casting to create the marriage of your dreams! It's a powerful process that will change your marriage (for the good)!

STEP 1: Listen For God's Voice

As we mentioned in the video, it is important that you are creating time to quiet your mind while you both spend time in God's Word and prayer. Create some time today to spend some quiet time with God and ask Him for wisdom about His will for your marriage.

STEP 2: Write Down The Vision

What ever God shows you in your time with him, be sure to write it down below. This way you will see the vision in front of you and will be more likely to follow through and get it done.

STEP 3: Prayerfully Compose a Plan

Now that you have a vision for your marriage (it could be just one area of focus, or several) it's time to start creating the plans to help you get there. For an example, let's do a monthly plan for your marriage.

Here are some great questions to start with:

What is one thing we'd like to work toward as a couple over the next month?

What is one action step we can take today to work towards this goal?

How much time should we spend each day working toward our goal?

What will we do if we don't meet our goal this month?

Once you work through these questions you'll have a wonderful idea of where you are heading together. When couple's work together as a team toward the same goal, there is no stopping them! There is something so powerful about being in agreement with God's plan for your marriage!
